JULIUS SCHWEISHEIMER (born Isak)

banker in Munich (1893-1909) together with his brother Eugen,
1912 in South America, 1914 in France and England, later
iron sheet trader in Munich (until 1935 top manager of Metall-Aetzwerk AG)
born 16 Dec 1863 Ederheim, died 23 Nov 1942 Theresienstadt
parents = Wolf Schweisheimer + wife Miriam nee Kirchdoerfer

married 18 Jun 1899 in Fuerth

FRIEDA SCHOENTHAL

born 20 Apr 1875 Fuerth, died 13 May 1941 Munich
parents = factory owner Philipp Schoenthal + wife Ida nee Ullmann

CHILDREN (all born in Munich):

- (01) **FRITZ WALTER** 8 Mar 1900 - 25 May 1900
- (02) **MAGDA** 6 Apr 1901 - 10 Jun 1901
- (03) **RUTH** (A) 27 Aug 1908 - 27 Sep 2005 (died in New York)

ROBERT ? KRAEMER (from Illinois ?)

ERNST BUSTIN from Kochel (Bavaria)
lived with parents in Munich since 1926
25 Sep 1903 - ? (died in Buenos Aires ?)
parents = iron dealer Emanuel Martin Bustin
(1871-1939) + wife Helene nee Rosenberger

couple emigrated to Buenos Aires (Argentina)
in 1938 together with Ernst's mother Helene +
brother Franz Joseph Bustin (born 19 Jan 1902)

Ernst Bustin changed first name to "Ernesto"
and founded "Ernesto Bustin SA", manufacturer
of industrial tools, still existing in 2010.

(A) Ruth Schweisheimer in 1932 wrote a doctoral thesis on famous German sculptor Johann Georg Dirr (1723-1779) at Art Department of Munich University. She might have married Robert Kraemer (born in Chicago ?) around 1929 and definitely emigrated to the USA in 1936, where she got naturalized on 24 Jan 1944 and signed "Ruth Shearer Kraemer" ("Shearer" = americanized for "Schweisheimer").
