born 22 Feb 1851 Laupheim, died 21 Nov 1928 Noerdlingen
(parents = Aron Gunz + wife Fanny nee Wuenschbacher)

married 16 Nov 1875 in Laupheim

KAROLINA GIDEON

born 27 Oct 1850 Rexingen, died ? (before 1928, as Isak died as a widower)
(parents = Moses Gideon + wife Regina nee Pressburger)

in 1930 Marcus's sister-in-law Ida Weiler (age 54)

| (05) SOPHIE | 13 Sep 1882 - 23 Nov 1924 (died in Rexingen)
married ca 1905 butcher + inn keeper "Zum Kaiser"
Siegmond Gideon in Rexingen
26 Oct 1875 Rexingen - 14 Jul 1931 Rexingen
couple had three children = Max 27 Jun 1906,
Arthur 23 Apr 1909-19 Aug 1929 (died in Karlsruhe)
and Karl 30 Nov 1913 |
| (06) SIGMUND | ca 1887 - ? (died after 1930, in New York ?)
in 1930 he was a salesman for bakery supplies,
married his wife Ida (born ca 1888 in Germany,
couple had a son Martin (born ca 1911 in New York) |
| (07) FRITZ
(called Frederick) | 01 Sep 1888 - December 1966 (died Erie, Erie PA)
owner of a bakery in New York, married
his wife Lina NN (born ca 1888 in Germany), |
| (08) BENNO ? or Hermann ? | ? - ? |

In 1928 there was also a daughter "Bluma" who had married NN Huber and had died before 1928 in Great Falls, Montana USA (couple had two children)
