EDUARD (born Emanuel) HOECHSTAEDTER (A) leather dealer in Moenchsdeggingen, since 1861 in Noerdlingen born 31 Jul 1818 Moenchsdeggingen, died 11 Apr 1904 Noerdlingen (parents = Jakob Hirsch Hoechsteadter + wife Ranle nee Oberdorfer) married 19 Jul 1842 in Pfaefflingen KLARA OBERMEIER born 26 Aug 1824 Hainsfarth, died 11 Jun 1906 Noerdlingen (parents = Nathan Michael Obermeier + wife Bessele nee Haussmann) CHILDREN (all born in Moenchsdeggingen): (01) SIGMUND 20 Aug 1843 - 05 Jul 1921 (died in Stuttgart) married 25 Nov 1873 in Cannstatt near Stuttgart Emma Stern of Rexingen 26 Sep 1852 Rexingen - 23 Oct 1932 Stuttgart (parents = Samuel Stern + Elsbeth n. Hirschfelder) 25 Aug 1845 - 03 Mar 1916 (died in Stuttgart) (02) PESSELE (Peppi) married NN Riess, who probably died before 1913 (03) ROSA 09 May 1847 - ? (04) SOPHIE 04 Mar 1849 - ? (05) EMMA (B) 21 Aug 1850 - 18 Dec 1921 (died in Stuttgart) married 8 May 1872 in Stuttgart Moritz Hirschfelder, wine merchant in Stuttgart 31 May 1844 Rexingen - 9 Apr 1913 Stuttgart (parents = Feit Hirschfelder + wife Mirjam nee Zirndorfer)

(A) In 1861 Eduard Hoechstaedter became the first Jewish citizen of Noerdlingen after the expulsion of all Jewish families in 1507. The Jewish community of Noerdlingen was founded again in 1870. The Jewish cemetery of Noerdlingen exists since 1878. The synagogue was built in 1885/86.

(B) Three sons out of this marriage = Martin 24 Jun 1873 - 6 Mar 1923,
Otto 3 Mar 1876 - 7 Jan 1904, Carl 23 Oct 1879 - 20 Oct 1930,
Gustav 1885 - 16 Dec 1939 (they all lived and died in Stuttgart).
