(A) Eugen Schweisheimer had a banking business in Munich, starting in 1885 with his partner Simon Dispecker. In 1893 Simon Dispecker was replaced by Eugen's brother Julius. In 1924 Eugen's son Robert became partner. In 1938 the bank at Theatiner Strasse 8 had eight employees and was shut down by the Nazi government. At that time the banking business was worth 2.7 Mio Reichsmark.

(B) Eugen Schweisheimer and his wife Melitta were divorced in 1903. Melitta thereafter married Michael Berolzheimer (born 22 Feb 1866 Fuerth), he had two children so far = Anneliese + Peter. Maybe Eugen Schweisheimer also married again after his divorce ?

(C) Waldemar Schweisheimer became a physician in Munich with an outstanding reputation in the twenties. He became famous for his studies on Beethoven's deafness and Schubert's health problems, he wrote about Maimonides medical opinions in relation with modern medicine. His work dealt mainly with social and hygienic medicine. In the thirties he emigrated to the USA. He published articles there until the late sixties or early seventies.
